



## PPCU Scholarship Program - 2020 Eligibility, Application Requirements and Policies

### Amount of Scholarships

PPCU will award five scholarships of \$1,000 each to chosen recipients.

### Eligibility

To be eligible, students must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ **The Applicant must be a PPCU Member in good standing.** To become a PPCU member, complete and submit a Membership form which is available online at [www.ppcu.org](http://www.ppcu.org) or at any branch.
- ✓ Be a 2020 graduating high school senior who will be enrolled in an accredited 2- or 4-year college or vocational/trade school for the Fall of 2020 **OR**
- ✓ A current college or vocational school student who will continue schooling towards a degree in an accredited 2- or 4-year college or vocational/trade school for the Fall of 2020
- ✓ Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50
- ✓ Previous PPCU Scholarship recipients are not eligible
- ✓ PPCU Employees and Members of the PPCU Board of Directors and Supervisory Committee are not eligible

### Application Requirements

Complete and submit a **Scholarship Application Form** and provide the information and documents stated on the application.

### Deadline and Policies

2. **Work Experience (last 3 years):** List jobs you have held in the past **3** years. For each job, give: Employer, Position, Dates, Hours Worked per Week.

3. **Honors and Awards (during last 2 years):** For each award/honor, provide: Sponsor of the Award, Date received, and Why you won the award.

4. **Essay:** 500 words on the following: *“What banking features and services do you want your credit union to provide and how would you market these to your age group?”*

5. **Latest Official sealed High school or College Transcript** showing Cumulative GPA (**must be at least 2.50**).

6. **If you are a Graduating High School Senior:** Provide official correspondence showing acceptance to an accredited college or vocational school for the upcoming school year.

**If you are a Current College Student:** Provide official documents showing registered classes for the current term.
